The Narrowboat “Wharram Percy”



Wharram Percy is a 58ft narrowboat with a semi-traditional stern and all home comforts for an extended stay for two to four people.

Starting at the bow, there is an area external to the entry point with seating and lockers. You step down from there to a **lounge** area with wood floors and a multi-fuel stove. There is also central heating throughout the boat from the stove.



The **galley** adjoins the lounge. The galley has a four-burner stove, separate oven and grill, fridge with separate freezer compartment, toaster, washer/dryer, and microwave.



Next is a four-seat **dinette** that converts to a double bed. With ample under seat storage, and the privacy of internal doors, this is an ideal second bedroom for hosting guests.



The **bathroom** has a shower, washbasin and cassette toilet.



Next there is a **bedroom** with a door for privacy and a fixed double bed. The bedroom has portholes rather than windows for additional privacy.



There is a wardrobe, and then stairs leading to a semi traditional stern with seating. The engine is a Beta Marine diesel (ETRR's favorite!) with a large alternator and inverter to support appliances such as washer, microwave, toaster, and hair dryer. The engine has to be running when the washer is in use, but smaller appliances will run off an inverter, so there is no need to run the engine for these.

Wharram Percy is named after an abandoned medieval village in Yorkshire, which had been the subject of intense archeological research for forty years. We hope that you will “dig” our Wharram Percy, too.
